What are Endorsed Programs?

Endorsed Programs are significant learning experiences developed by schools, community organisations, or private providers, and they are endorsed by the School Curriculum and Standards Authority (Authority) for students in Years 10, 11, and 12.

Unlock Unique Learning Opportunities

Endorsed Programs provide a wide array of activities beyond traditional school courses or vocational education and training. Students can engage in enriching extra-curricular and workplace learning experiences, broadening their horizons and skill sets.



WACE Recognition

Achievement in Endorsed Programs can contribute to the Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) requirements and will be documented on the student's Western Australian Statement of Student Achievement (WASSA).

Validating Your Learning

To receive credit towards WACE for Endorsed Programs, students must present: a statement of attainment, qualification, academic transcript, certificate, or award as evidence of their learning achievements.
