Value of Bursary:

50% of tuition fees for Year 10, Year 11 and Year 12 at Our Lady of Mercy College.

P&F BURSARIES

These Bursaries are provided by the P&F and are determined on a need's basis. They are intended to assist parents in offsetting some of the costs associated with attending the College. Generally, applicants would be in receipt of a Health Care Card or other concession card to be considered eligible.

Who can apply?

Students commencing Year 10 in 2024.

Value of Bursary:

Up to \$400.00 financial contribution to be determined on an individual and confidential basis. It is payable for one year only.

How to Apply

To apply for a 2024 Scholarship or Bursary, please complete the Scholarship/Bursary Application Form on the reverse and include the following documents:

Academic, Sport, Art, Technology Scholarships:

- Student composed letter of introduction which details current interests and achievements as well as future ambitions. The letter should not exceed a typed A4 page (1-sided).
- Our Mercy values of Compassion, Justice, Respect, Hospitality, Service and Courage, guide our students to live a life of purpose. Scholarship applicants are asked to provide a 200-word written response which outlines the value which most appeals to them and indicate how this value might be integrated into their day to day living.
- A copy of the latest school report.

Catholic Bursaries & P&F Bursaries:

- Parent composed letter of introduction which sets out their current family and financial circumstances. Parents should indicate the areas in which they need assistance. The letter should not exceed a typed A4 page (1-sided).
- A copy of the latest school report.

Applications are to be returned by mail or can be emailed to enrolments@olmca.wa.edu.au by **Monday, 4 December 2023** (Term 4, Week 9). Late applications will not be accepted.

All applications will be considered by a panel. The final decision on awarding any Scholarships and Bursaries rests with the Principal.

The Scholarship and Bursary recipients will be notified by mail on or before **Tuesday**, **12 December 2023**.

- All the Scholarship holders and Bursary recipients are expected to display ongoing commitment to their studies as well as show evidence of our Mercy values of Compassion, Respect, Hospitality, Service, Courage and Justice in every aspect of their life.
- The school reserves the right not to award any or all the Scholarships and Bursaries available.
- The cost of books, stationery, uniforms, or discretionary charges such as camps or overseas trips are not included in the Scholarship or Bursary.
- The Scholarship or Bursary will be considered with any sibling discounts or special arrangements.
- Scholarship and Bursary holders are expected to maintain a high level of commitment to the whole school program. This includes school attendance, being a positive influence in all classes, completion of work, excellent citizenship, wearing the uniform correctly, attendance at school functions, active contribution to the co-curricular house and voluntary school activities and doing his/her best at all times. Failure to observe these conditions may result in the withdrawal of the scholarship or bursary.
- The family agrees to fully abide by the rules and conditions at Our Lady of Mercy College as outlined in its Code of Conduct and policies.
- Acceptance of the Scholarship or Bursary is required within ten business days of the offer being made.
