

YEAR 7 SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES FOR 2024

Our Lady of Mercy College Australind is a nurturing co-educational secondary College for students from Year 7 to Year 12. Scholarships and Bursaries

Inspired by Catherine McAuley, the founder of the Sisters of Mercy, the College also offers Bursaries (monetary assistance) to enable students to attend our College, when they might otherwise not have been able to do so.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

An Academic Scholarship is an award of financial assistance to enable a student to further their education. Our Academic Scholarships are awarded based upon various criteria

Number of Scholarships available:

- Four scholarships for students from Catholic Primary Schools entering Year 7 in 2024.
- Two scholarships for students from other Primary Schools entering Year 7 in 2024.

Who can apply?

Students due to commence Year 7 in 2024.

Value of Scholarship:

50% of tuition fees for Year 7, Year 8 and Year 9 at Our Lady of Mercy College.

MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS

A Music Scholarship is an award of financial assistance to enable a student to further their education. Our Music Scholarships are awarded based upon various criteria.

Number of Scholarships available:

· Nine scholarships for students entering Year 7 in 2024.

Who can apply?

Students due to commence Year 7 in 2024.

Value of scholarship:

Year 7: 100% Group Lesson costs & 100% Instrumental hire. Year 8: 100% Group Lesson costs & 100% Instrumental hire.

FIRST NATIONS BURSARIES

The following bursaries are available to First Nations students currently attending the College or students enrolling for 2024.

- Rose First Nations Bursaries
- MADALAH Scholarships

Who can apply?

First Nations students currently attending Our Lady of Mercy College or students enrolling for 2024. The level of financial contribution is determined on an individual and confidential basis.

Value of scholarship:

Up to 50% of tuition fees for the remaining duration of schooling at Our Lady of Mercy College.

P&F BURSARIES

These Bursaries are provided by the P&F and are determined on a needs basis. They are intended to assist parents to offset some of the costs associated with commencing at the College. Generally, applicants would be in receipt of a Health Care Card or other concession card to be considered eligible.

Who can apply?

Students due to commence Year 7 in 2024.

Value of scholarship:

Up to \$600.00 financial contribution to be determined on an individual and confidential basis. It is payble only during the first year at the College.
