## DESCRIPTION OF YEAR 8 ELECTIVES ON OFFER IN 2022

<b>VISUAL ART</b>	Explore, design and create your own unique artwork. You will learn drawing and design techniques, utilising a variety of drawing media and you will develop new skills in an exciting art form, such as clay, printmaking, painting, or textiles.
<b>MEDIA ARTS</b>	Learn how to use a camera like a photographer and create some amazing images. Students are introduced to Photoshop and learn how to use it as a tool for photos. Learn all about creating a film from writing a script, filming and editing. Students will have hands on experience, getting behind the camera and creating their own productions.
<b>DANCE</b>	Learn Jazz dance skills and a class routine as well as working with your friends to create your own dance. You even get the chance to dance on stage in costumes, but only if you want to.
<b>DRAMA</b>	Grow in confidence and creativity as you continue to build your knowledge of spontaneous improvisation and warm-up activities. Then experience the impact of a rehearsed performance through exploring the choices that an actor makes and/or technical decisions made in relation to lighting, costume and sound design; as you prepare and perform scenes for an audience of your choice.
<b>MUSIC</b>	Create and explore music through performance, listening and analysis. Develop your composition, theory and aural skills and learn how to perform with your friends in your own rock band.
<b>MATERIALS TECHNOLOGY (Metal/Plastics)</b>	Explore and use a range of different materials to create items that are both fun and interesting. A variety of materials, such as metals, plastics, wood and glass may be used to create a range of useful and decorative products. The development of hand skills, safe use of equipment and processes, as well as exploring the design process will be a feature of this Course.
<b>FOOD</b>	Food & You. Students will revise the basic concepts that were covered in Year Seven for the first part of the unit and then the focus will shift to the need to start the day with a healthy breakfast.
<b>COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY</b>	Discover the world of graphic design in Business. This course will provide students with the opportunities to use online software to design and create business logos, business cards, invitations and more! Learn to use Scratch to program and share interactive media projects such as digital stories, games and animation.
<b>COMPUTERS IN BUSINESS</b>	Explore and learn skills with Microsoft Office 365 using Word and PowerPoint to enhance the design and presentation of professional standard documents. Learn valuable tips and tricks to make more creative and successful PowerPoint Presentations. Find out the tips and tricks you need to know so that you can use Word like a pro. Whether you need to create a cover page, write a letter or create an assignment, Microsoft Word is ready and waiting!
<b>LEADERSHIP AND PERFORMANCE</b>	The Year 8 Program is a Semester based program which focuses on introducing students to identifying and developing their own strengths and weakness through a Personal Performance Tracker. Learning is targeted towards fitness testing, the structure and value of accurate and meaningful training and nutrition. Practical sessions include, but are not limited to cardiovascular and strength training, methods of training and a range of striking and invasion games such as indoor cricket and NFL.
<b>SCIENCE</b>	Who thought of a scooter you can kneel on to help people who cannot use crutches? Life needs exploration, imagination and innovation to solve problems. In this elective you will be challenged to create a different way of solve a problem that challenges society today by using your imagination and creativity.
